NOTICE OF RACE

The event will be classified Category "C" in accordance with RRS appendix 1.

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and the event supplementary sailing instructions.

Conditions of Entry

The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat, who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions, nor the inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for his/her crew his/her boat and the management thereof. The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

Sailors must be 18 years and under on 31st December 2018

Entries will be accepted on the morning of commencement of the racing from 09:00 hrs.

Entry Fee £8 single handed boats and £10 for double handed (cheques made to "Cransley Sailing Club" please)

Race Briefing 13:15 :

Race 1 at 13.30, followed by a short break and two subsequent races back to back

It is anticipated that prize giving will take place shortly after 17:00

The Event Supplementary sailing instructions will be available at time of entry or registration.

Parents / Guardians are not permitted on the water to coach / give instruction to their child/ren If they are one of the official Instructors they will be given a group to coach that does not include their child/ren.

Statement of Risk

Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is his or hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;

Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

Safety Boat Cover

Safety boat cover will be provided by Cransley SC. No boats other than safety and competitor's boats will be allowed on the water whilst the event is taking place.

Check, Clean, Dry

Cransley Sailing Club supports the policy set by Anglian Water and the Department for Environment Food and Rural Affairs to help restrict the spread of non-native species in our water. The principle of [Check Clean Dry](#) already applies to craft and equipment leaving our premises and the Club members would like our visitors to support this initiative by ensuring that their boats and equipment are washed down before they leave other sites and are dry before being used on Cransley's water. As a guide there should be a minimum of two days drying time between wash down and being used on another water.
